1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to sailing dinghies and yachts
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the appropriate entry form.

- 2.4. Completed entry forms should be sent to the Sailing Secretary at the Elephant Boatyard, Lands End, Old Bursledon, Southampton SO31 8DN by Thursday, 26th August, 2010
- 2.5 Late entries will be accepted at the Race Officer's discretion.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third placed boats in each race, provided sufficient boats enter..

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
